
The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child

All children have rights, no matter what



Adults should do what is best for children



Government must help children enjoy their rights



Families should guide children to learn their rights



Every child has the right to be alive



Children have the right to have a name and belong to a countru



Children have a riaht to have an identity: to be who they are



Children should stay with their parents unless a parent does not take proper care of a child



If a child lives in a different country to their parents, governments must let them travel so they can be together



Governments must protect children from kidnapping

Children have the right to share what they learn, think and feel

Children without families have the right to be looked after by other people who respect them



When a child is adopted, the adults who adopt them must do what is best for them



Children who move to another country because it was not safe for them to stay in their home country should be given help



Governments should help children with disabilities to enjoy their best life possible



Children have the right to healthy food, clean water, a safe environment and the best health care possible



Children who live away from their families or home should be checked on to make sure that they are in the best place for them to be



Children from poor families should receive money or other help from the government so they can grow up in the best possible way



The government should help families who cannot afford to provide food, clothing, and a safe place to live for their children



Every child has the right to free and safe education



Education for children should help them to develop, teach them to understand their rights and to respect other people's rights



Children have the right to use their own language, celebrate their culture and practise their religion



Children have the right to rest, relax and play



Children should be protected from doing work that is dangerous or bad for them



Governments must protect children from being near harmful druas



All adults should protect children from all kinds of abuse and harm
